Notes from the Choir Loft:



New beginnings, while exciting, can also be unsettling as different people do things differently. It is certainly the case with church musicians, who strive to make the various musical offerings each week as uplifting and meaningful as possible. As I learn more about Holy Trinity's traditions and preferences, I hope I will also be able to share some of my musical experiences with you and, perhaps, they will become a part of your ongoing Song.

One significant change has been to how the Psalm is presented. The idea behind moving to the Simplified Anglican Chant is to continue the

ancient tradition of chanting the Psalm, but in a way that is accessible to everyone, not just the choir. I will always play the Chant through once, and then you are welcome to sing the melody, or any of the harmony parts available. The underlined word in the Psalm indicates when to change the musical pitch.

This form of Psalm singing is embraced by most parishes in this Diocese and throughout the country, so the hope is that not only will it help you connect with the Psalm here, but to be able to participate with confidence anywhere you may visit in our greater Episcopal church family.

Please know all the hymns and anthems are chosen with great care to illuminate the Readings for the day. I do all I can to prepare your gifted and giving Choir to be effective leaders in our hymns and liturgy, but they are most effective when the congregation joins in with energy and enthusiasm. Our liturgy shines when we all participate as we can. Please know YOU make a difference!

I look forward to getting to know more of you as the days unfold and to hearing your voices resound as Holy Trinity continues to be a place where the Living God is found is all we do in His Name.

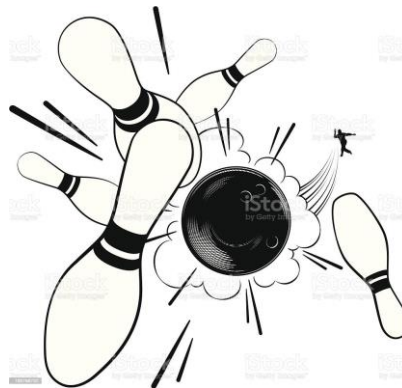

can organize our first walk & meditation! Any questions, please see Leslie or Fr. Keith.

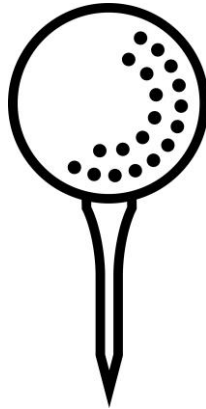
